Encounter: Telephone review

Reason for contact: Abnormal renal result

History

Telephone review following renal monitoring after recent naproxen initiation for lumbar radicular pain. Patient reports no vomiting or diarrhoea. Urine output preserved.

Results

Renal function final: deterioration from baseline, with creatinine increased from patient baseline. Reported as possible NSAID-related renal deterioration.

Assessment

Renal function deterioration following naproxen initiation.

Plan

- Cease naproxen 250 mg twice daily with food.
- Arrange repeat renal function test after naproxen cessation.
- Advised to avoid non-prescribed NSAIDs.
- Continue losartan 50 mg once daily and paracetamol as required.
- Lumbar MRI remains outstanding if symptoms persist.

Medication changes

Naproxen 250 mg twice daily - ceased 17 August 2026. Reason: creatinine increased after initiation.

Safety-netting

Advised to avoid non-prescribed NSAIDs.
