PRESENTATION

Brought to the emergency department by ambulance following a witnessed generalised seizure at her workplace at approximately 08:00. Consciousness was recovered prior to transport. A minor tongue bite was noted.

HISTORY

Known epilepsy, previously seizure-free for three years and normally independent. Regular medication levetiracetam 1000 mg twice daily. Known allergy to lamotrigine (previous rash). The patient disclosed that she had missed doses of levetiracetam during travel.

EXAMINATION

No focal neurological deficit identified.

INVESTIGATIONS

Electrolytes and glucose acceptable.

Levetiracetam level pending.

ASSESSMENT

Breakthrough seizure, likely related to interrupted levetiracetam adherence.

MEDICATION

Levetiracetam 1000 mg twice daily continued. No medication changes made at this presentation.

Levetiracetam level remains pending.
