## Reason for contact

Post-ED follow-up to review breakthrough seizure, levetiracetam level result and adherence.

## History

- Background of epilepsy, previously seizure-free for three years and normally independent.
- Presented to Logan Hospital Emergency Department on 02/09/2026 after a breakthrough seizure. ED documented no focal neurological deficit, acceptable electrolytes and glucose, and that she disclosed missed levetiracetam doses during travel. Discharged same day after no recurrent seizure during observation, having returned to neurological baseline.
- ED advice included not to drive under applicable medical advice and to return for recurrent or prolonged seizure.
- Levetiracetam was resumed at 1000 mg twice daily on 02/09/2026.
- Levetiracetam level from the ED attendance was pending at discharge and finalised on 04/09/2026 as low, below the expected therapeutic range for the laboratory, supporting recent missed doses.
- At today's review, no further seizures reported.
- Allergy: lamotrigine - previous rash.

## Medication changes

- Levetiracetam 1000 mg twice daily - continued without dose change from 05/09/2026. Reason: no further seizure after regular dosing resumed. Status after change: active.
- No other medication changes today.

## Assessment

Breakthrough seizure on 02/09/2026, likely related to interrupted levetiracetam adherence. No further seizures since. Levetiracetam level low at the time of ED presentation, consistent with missed doses. Continue current levetiracetam regimen and expedite neurology review.

## Plan

- Continue levetiracetam 1000 mg twice daily.
- Medicine supply and reminder plan reviewed today.

- Expedite neurology outpatient review with Metro South Neurology Clinic.
- Community pharmacy adherence support to continue.
- GP review within 7 days completed today, 05/09/2026.
- Review of levetiracetam level completed today, 05/09/2026.

### **Safety-netting**

- Do not drive under applicable medical advice.
- Return or seek urgent care for recurrent or prolonged seizure.

### **Follow-up**

- Neurology outpatient review - Metro South Neurology Clinic, due 18/09/2026 - outstanding.
- Pharmacy adherence support - community pharmacist, due 12/09/2026 - outstanding.
