Reason for contact

Adherence support following recent interrupted levetiracetam dosing and breakthrough seizure.

Background

- Epilepsy; previously seizure-free for three years and normally independent.
- Allergy: lamotrigine - previous rash.
- Emergency department attendance on 02/09/2026 with breakthrough seizure after missed levetiracetam doses. Discharged same day after no recurrent seizure; returned to neurological baseline.
- Levetiracetam resumed at 1000 mg twice daily on 02/09/2026.
- Levetiracetam level finalised on 04/09/2026 as low, below the expected therapeutic range for the laboratory, supporting recent missed doses.
- GP review on 05/09/2026: no further seizures reported; continue levetiracetam 1000 mg twice daily and expedite neurology review.

Current medication

- Levetiracetam 1000 mg twice daily - active. Continued without dose change.

Medication changes at this visit

- None. No medication starts, stops, or dose changes were made.

Adherence support provided

- Dose organiser and refill reminder arranged.
- Practical adherence support implemented.

Plan

- Current prescribed regimen remains levetiracetam 1000 mg twice daily.
- Use arranged dose organiser and refill reminder to support regular dosing.
- Neurology outpatient review with Metro South Neurology Clinic remains outstanding, due 18/09/2026.
- Community pharmacy adherence support completed 08/09/2026.
- GP review completed 05/09/2026.
- Review of levetiracetam level completed 05/09/2026.

Safety-netting

- Follow previous ED advice: do not drive under applicable medical advice.
- Return for recurrent or prolonged seizure.
