Reason for contact

Discuss urine culture result and rash.

History

Telephone review. Patient reports the rash is settling and urinary symptoms are improving.

Results reviewed

Urine culture (specimen collected 29 August 2026) - final: organism susceptible to nitrofurantoin and resistant to trimethoprim.

Assessment

- Urinary tract infection improving on nitrofurantoin. Culture confirms susceptibility to nitrofurantoin, so the current antibiotic is appropriate.
- Probable trimethoprim allergy following generalised urticarial rash after two doses on 30 August 2026. Rash settling. No airway involvement previously documented.

Plan

- Continue nitrofurantoin 100 mg twice daily. No change.
- Permanently update allergy list to record trimethoprim allergy.
- Urine culture review completed.

Medication changes

No changes at this review.

Current: Nitrofurantoin 100 mg twice daily - active.

Trimethoprim - ceased 30 August 2026.

Safety-netting

Seek emergency care for breathing difficulty or facial swelling.

Follow-up

- Update and verify trimethoprim allergy record - due 6 September 2026, GP, Eight Mile Plains Family Practice. Outstanding.
- Communicate new antibiotic allergy to regular GP - completed 1 September 2026.
