Presenting problem

Recurrent falls and dizziness. Spouse reported a second fall in one week after standing, occurring at home on 23 August 2026. No head strike reported. Left elbow bruising reported. Spouse arranged emergency department assessment.

Background

Parkinson disease, hypertension, benign prostatic hyperplasia. Lives with spouse and receives community physiotherapy.

Medications on presentation

- Amlodipine 5 mg once daily
- Levodopa/carbidopa 100/25 mg three times daily
- Tamsulosin 400 micrograms nightly

Examination

Postural blood pressure drop documented. Left elbow bruising reported by spouse.

Investigations

Left elbow X-ray final: no fracture.

No infection identified.

Assessment

Orthostatic hypotension likely contributing to falls. No left elbow fracture. No infection identified.

Medication changes

Nil.

Management

No medication changes made during this ED episode.
