Reason for contact

Unilateral calf swelling.

History

Patient reports left calf pain and swelling since returning from a long-distance flight. No chest pain or breathlessness. Background of obesity, hypertension, and obstructive sleep apnoea. No known drug allergies. Current medication: Olmesartan 20 mg once daily. Recently returned from long-distance travel.

Findings

Left calf visibly larger. Localised tenderness. No respiratory symptoms.

Assessment

Possible deep vein thrombosis (DVT) of the left leg. Requires same-day ultrasound and emergency department assessment.

Plan

- Refer to Logan Hospital Emergency Department for same-day assessment and ultrasound.
- Patient advised to attend ED immediately.
- Safety-netting: Call emergency services for chest pain or breathlessness.
- No medication changes.
- Follow-up: Same-day ED and ultrasound assessment outstanding.
